

The Iron Workers Local 396 Death Benefit Fund

In January of 2002 a resolution was passed to provide educational assistance to each child of an Iron Worker killed on the job. This resolution was incorporated in the Local Union By-Laws to Article IX, and to be known as "section 9, Death Benefit Scholarship Fund".

Benefit Rules

- 1) Only sons/daughters of members who were killed on a union job qualify for this benefit.
- 2) The deceased member must have been current in regard to union dues and assessments.
- 3) A one-time grant in the amount of one thousand (\$1000.00) dollars will be awarded for post secondary schooling of the child's choice.
- 4) This benefit is available only upon written proof that one semester has been completed from the institution attended.
